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## Steps for Installing QQube






Single-User installations are simple, and encouraged for evaluations. Multi-user installations on a local network may or may not require IT assistance. But remote desktop environments most likely will.

### STEP [1] Review the Pre-Install Requirements



[Start Here](#). Ensure that you have satisfied the [Pre-Install Requirements](#), including technical hardware/software specs, QuickBooks and application pre-requisites; and implemented the workstation or server configuration necessities.

### STEP [2] Choose the Proper Installation

	<p><a href="#">Single User (Workstation Only)</a>. This type of installation can only be used on a desktop or laptop - not a server - and all of its components will be installed on your machine. It doesn't matter whether the QuickBooks data is stored locally or on the server.</p>
	<p><a href="#">Multi-User (Local Network Option)</a>. The QQube database is installed on the server under the local administrator, and communicates with QuickBooks via a client copy of QuickBooks. QQube client software is installed on a workstation to communicate with the QQube database on the server.</p>
	<p><a href="#">Multi-User (Hosted or Remote Desktop Environment)</a>. The QQube database is installed under a specific dedicated server user, and communicates with QuickBooks via a client copy of QuickBooks. Remote users will have access to view synch logs, and run reports.</p> <p><b>This is a required method if anybody remotely logs in to the server to use QuickBooks.</b></p>

After installation follow the required [QQube First Time Setup](#) instructions.
